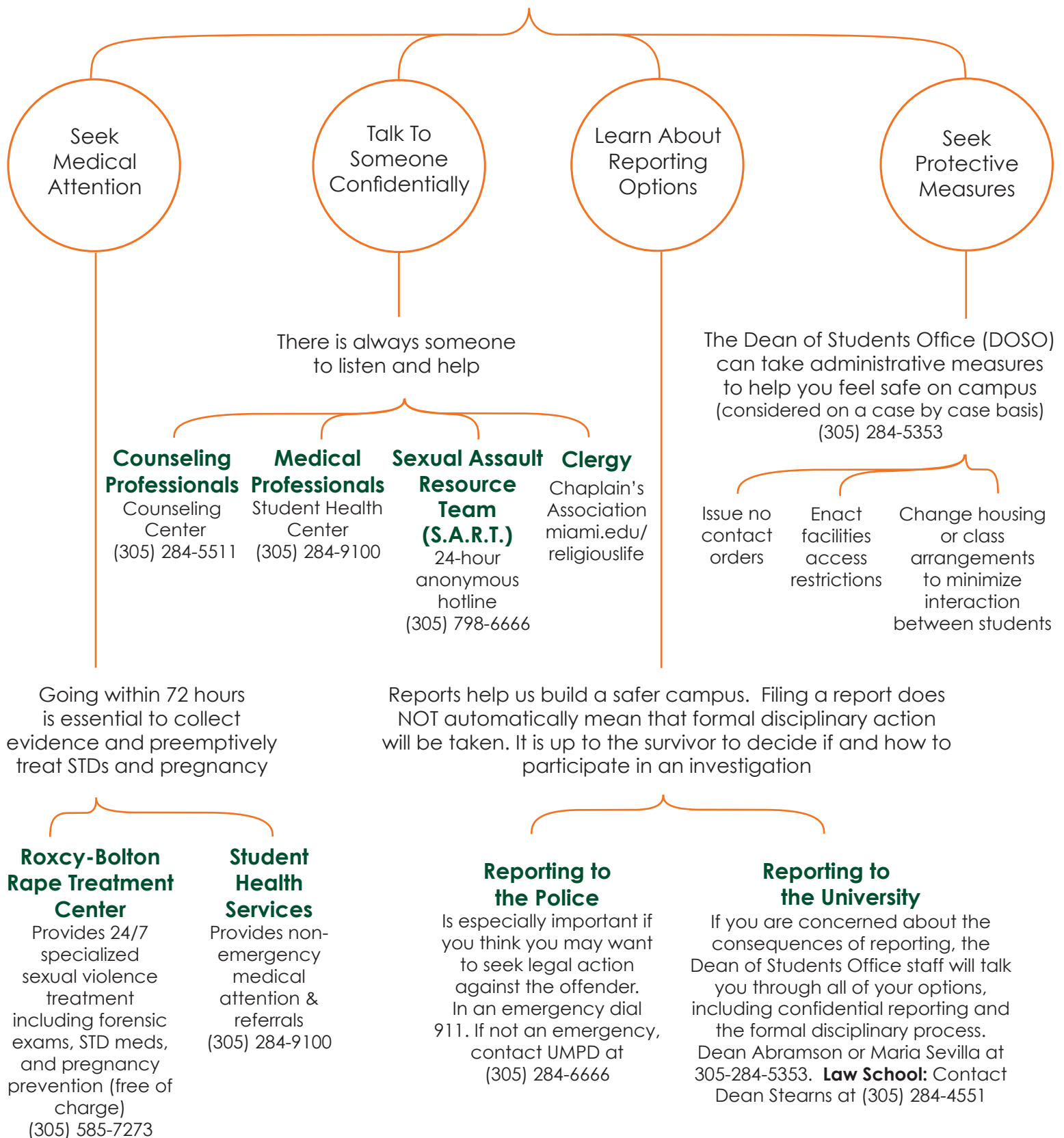

What is **SEXUAL MISCONDUCT?**

Sexual misconduct includes the following specific policies: **Relationship and/or Intimate Partner Violence, Sexual Assault, Sexual Harassment, and Stalking.**

What is **GENDER DISCRIMINATION?**

Gender Discrimination refers to **any act that was committed against another person because of that person's gender or their gender expression.** For example, an act of assault committed against another person because of that person's actual or perceived gender would constitute an act of gender discrimination.

What is **SEXUAL ASSAULT?**

Commonly referred to as rape, sexual assault is defined for University purposes as **non-consensual oral, anal, or vaginal penetration** by or union with the sexual organ of another or by any other object, **or sexual touching** (fondling) or intentional contact with the breasts, buttocks, groin, or genitals. It is the most severe form of sexual misconduct.

What is **CONSENT?**

Consent is **intelligent, knowing, and voluntary agreement** to engage in a specific activity. Intoxication, age, and disability can seriously impair a person's ability to consent.
