

Graduate Employment Statistics for University of Miami School of Law's Class of 2009

88.4% of the University of Miami School of Law graduating class of 2009 seeking employment obtained positions or pursued further graduate studies within nine months of graduation.

93% of the University of Miami School of Law graduating class of 2009 whose employment status is known obtained positions or pursued further graduate studies within nine months of graduation.

Below are more detailed employment statistics for the class of 2009.

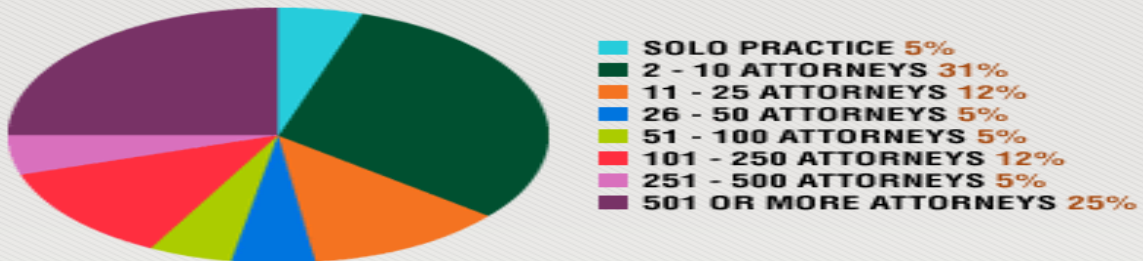

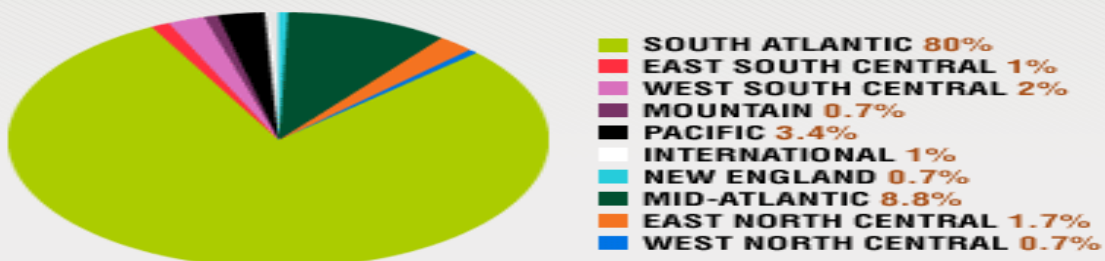

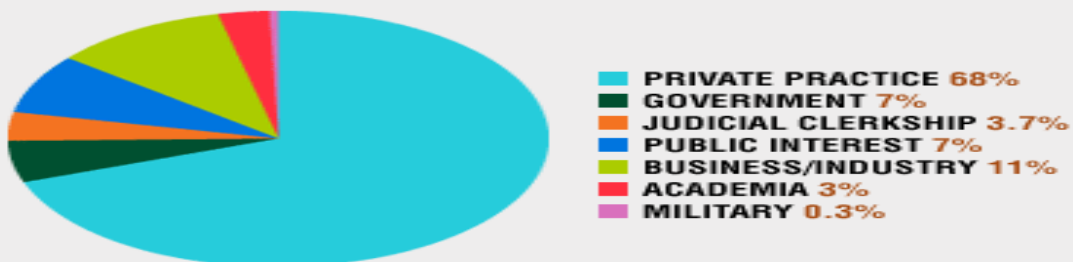
Firm Size (As of November 16, 2010)
