**Recovery of Cultural Property of Illicit Provenance
in Private and Public International Law**

Professor Guido Carducci



Dr. Guido Carducci has taught and published extensively on domestic and international private, economic and public law. He is a Law Professor in Paris and is the former chief of the Legal and Treaty Section at UNESCO. In that capacity he was in charge of four world-wide UNESCO Conventions, two Protocols and two Intergovernmental Committees for the protection of art, cultural property and heritage. Before joining UNESCO, Prof. Carducci was a member of the Italian delegation to UNESCO for the negotiation of the 2001 Convention for the Protection of Underwater Cultural Heritage. He also acted as mediator between governments, such as the UK and Greece regarding the Parthenon Marbles. He holds four post-graduate degrees (DEAs) and a *Maîtrise en droit* from the Universities Paris I and II, a PhD in law and two Laureas from the Universities of Rome I and II, and the Diploma from The Hague Academy of International Law. At Miami Law he teaches Recovery of Art and Cultural Property in International Law and the Protection of Underwater Cultural Heritage.
