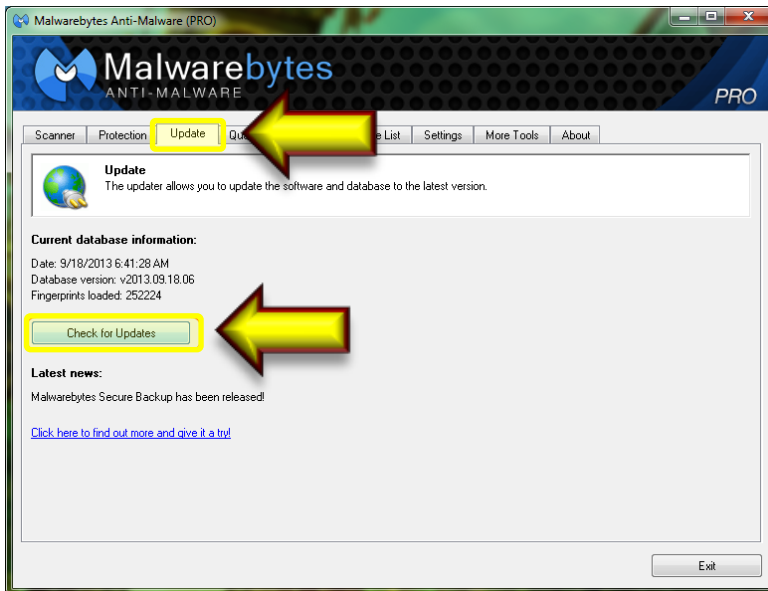


Malwarebytes is an anti-malware/spyware program that, when used in conjunction with an anti-virus program, helps keep your computer safe and secure.



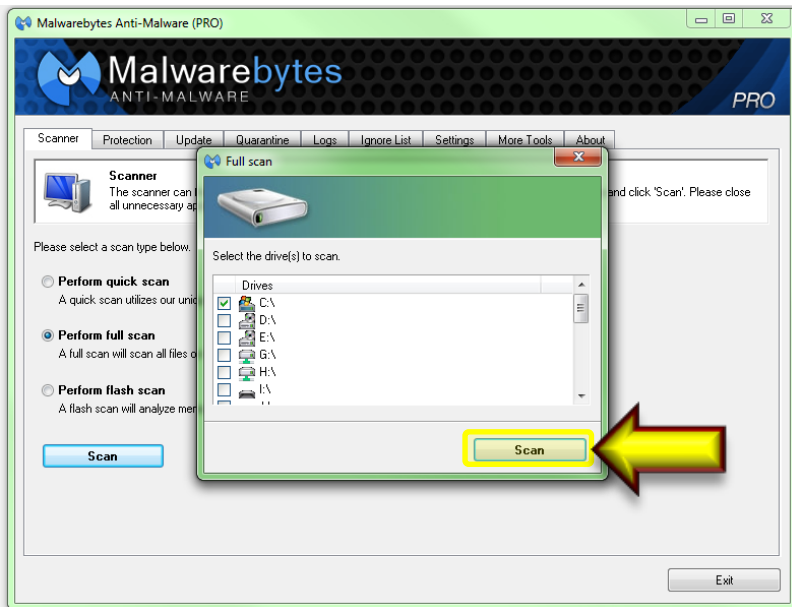
Once you have opened the program, click on the **Update** tab and click on **Check for Updates**.

If there are any updates, let them download and install. Once the program has finished, click on the **Scanner** tab.



There are three different types of scans to use; one of those scans (flash scan) can only be used if you have the paid licensed version:

Perform quick scan - This is a basic scan of your primary drive or partition (C: drive). It can take several minutes to complete (but less time than the full scan).



Perform Full scan - While a quick scan is usually recommended, the full scan will scan every file on the selected drives.

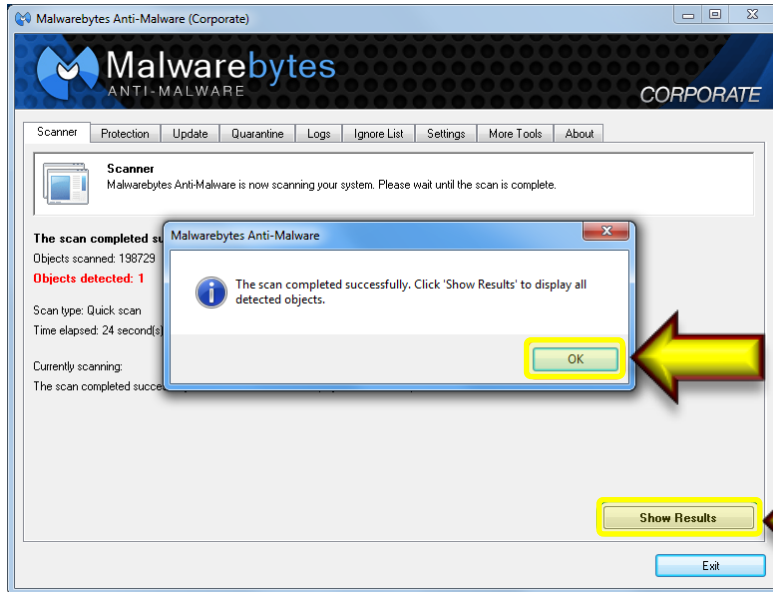
If you choose this option, a second window will open listing all of your connected drives (USB/CD/DVD/network). Select the drives you want scanned and click **Scan**.

This can take upwards of an hour or more to complete.



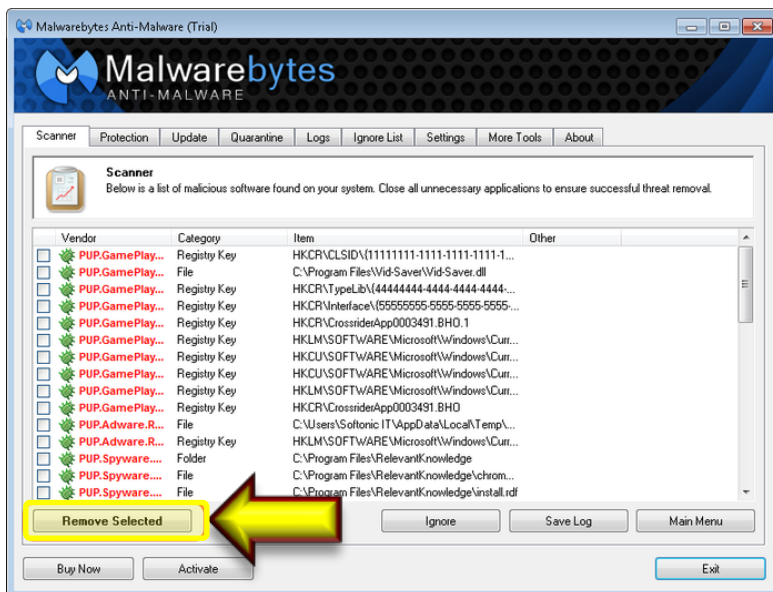
Perform Flash scan – This option is not available on the free version, only the paid version. It will analyze the memory and autorun objects.

Like the quick scan, this can take several minutes (but less time than the full scan).



If the scan finds infected files/objects, you will get a screen similar to the one shown.

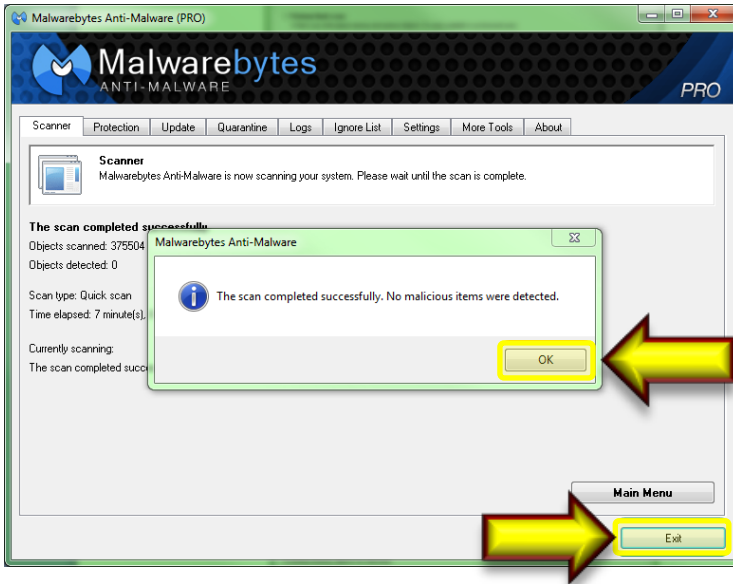
Click **OK** and then the **Show Results** button.



The next screen will list the infected files/objects. You will need to click on each **PUP (Potentially Unwanted Program)** you wish to remove.

Once you have checked the **PUP** files, click the **Remove Selected** button.

***Keep in mind that there may be files that are not malware and you may wish to keep them.**



In some cases, you may be asked to restart your computer in order for Malwarebytes to properly remove the infected files/objects.

If your computer is not infected, you will get a window similar to the one shown to appear. Click **OK** and then click **Exit** to close the program.
