International Arbitration in Latin America: Recent Developments and Future Prospects

Professor Andrés Jana

Professor Andrés Jana is a litigation and arbitration attorney and partner at the Chilean law firm of Bofill Mir & Alvarez Jana. Jana obtained his LL.M. from Harvard University and graduated *summa cum laude* from the Law School of the Universidad de Chile. The 2010 *Legal Who's Who* recognized him as one of the top five experts in international arbitration in Chile and he is regarded by Chambers & Partners as one of Chile's best litigation attorneys. Jana is the Chilean delegate before the United Nations Commission on International Trade Law (UNCITRAL), is a member of the ICC's Arbitration Committee and is on the Panel of Arbitrators for ICSID. He has acted as external advisor to the Chilean government, particularly to the Ministries of Energy, Foreign Affairs and Finance. He provided advice to the government during negotiations of the Free Trade Agreement (FTA) between Chile and the U.S., as well as the negotiations of the financial services and investment chapters of the FTA with the European Union. A Professor of Civil Law at the Universidad de Chile since 1997, he regularly lectures and publishes on international arbitration. At Miami Law, he teaches International Arbitration in Latin America in the International Arbitration LL.M. program.
